All dogs entered must be purebred and registered on the NZKC No. 1 or No. 3 register. Trials will be run under the NZGTA Rules & Regulations for Pointer & Setter Trials on Natural Game. Rules will be available at the trial. Competing dogs will be braced and may be required to wear collars with bells attached at the judges' discretion. There will be a thrown retrieve of a gamebird (pheasant) for placed dogs. All competitors must be members of an affiliated club. **CURRENT SEASON SHOOTING LICENSES MUST BE CARRIED BY ALL COMPETITORS.** The committee reserves the right to make any alteration to this schedule to meet any emergency. All competitors compete at their own risk. There is no training permitted on these grounds two weeks prior to the trial. Trial grounds may not be revisited by competitors at any time outside of Club trials.

**\*\*Firearms licenses must be presented by all competitors prior to the trial\*\***
